- Scuola Centrale Formazione is a no-profit organisation, recognised by the Italian Ministry of Labour, born in 1975, joins together 45 organisations managing about 100 VET centres distributed in 11 regions from the North, to theSouth of Italy.
- Since 2001 SCF has been promoting different initiatives for the valorisation of the transnational mobility as part of a consolidated mission, giving to thousands of young peopole, trainers, teachers and staff the possiblity to carry out a mobility experience abroad.
- This activity steadily increased led Scf firstly to publish a research about the ECVET methodological framework applied to transnational mobility pathways (GORES Mobility Experience Tools for the valorization of the learning outcomes in the transnational learning mobility and then to obtain the VET Mobility Charter. Thus the intense work in the field of coordination, management and organization of transnational mobility goes hand in hand with the research and study work on the various topics concerning this sector.
