About us

We are a group of three 18 year old students from *CFP Artigianelli*, a vocational school in Fermo, Italy. Our school focuses on creativity, craftsmanship, and innovation values that we have brought into our latest project.

We travelled to Lyon, France, to collaborate on the project of a clutch bag inspired by the theme of light. Through this work, we wanted to explore how light can shape design, influence mood, and bring elegance to everyday objects.

This experience was a great opportunity for us to exchange ideas, learn from others, and represent our school and our city abroad. We are proud of what we created.

About this project

Our project explores the theme of light through the design of a circular clutch bag inspired by the Moon, constellations, and planets.

After developing several sketches, we created four different Moon-inspired versions.

Using CAD software, we digitized our models and used a cutting machine to produce test samples, which we refined through adjustments and hand-stitching.

We then selected the final materials including leathers, rhinestones, and linings to achieve the best aesthetic result. We used the materials we had available and those provided by SEPR.

After completing the final cuts and assembly, we created our collection of four “Midnight” clutches, a creative interpretation of light where the Moon becomes a symbol of elegance and luminosity.

Students' project 1:



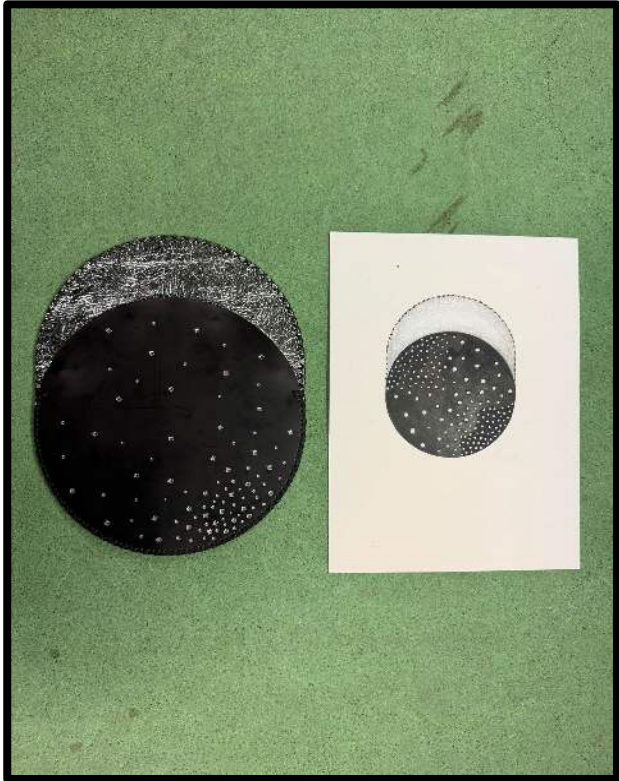
This is a half-moon clutch bag with a handle, made of black and silver leather with the black rhinestone motif that resembles a basketball.

Students' project 2:



This is the round clutch, we thought of using the silver part to create a half moon and using the patchwork on top of the black leather as if they were the moon's rays.

Students' project 3:



This model is the same as the previous one, but instead of using patchwork we used rhinestones. As for the design, in one corner the rhinestones are closer and in greater quantity and going further and further they gradually dissolve.

Students' project 4:



This is a round clutch bag with a handle, we used black leather as a patchwork over silver leather. As for the design, we were inspired by the surface of the moon and its craters that we represented using black leather.

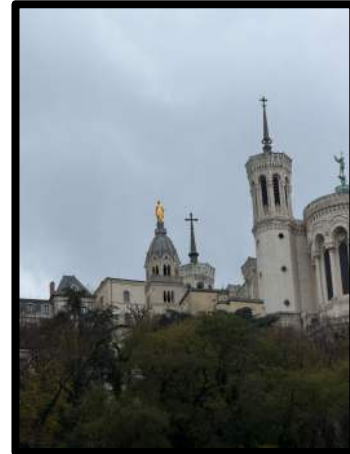
Out and about in Lyon
