DO YOUR MOB is the event promoted by Scuola Centrale Formazione, dedicated to transnational mobility and internationalisation processes within the Vocational Education and Training (VET) system.

The 14th edition of Do Your MOB will take place in Milan, Italy, from 3 to 5 November 2026 and will feature a renewed format, with two parallel programmes:

- Job Shadowing and Workshops for professionals involved in the management of mobility projects and the internationalisation processes of their organisations.
- International Skills Competitions for Initial VET learners in the fields of Hospitality and Catering, Beauty and Wellness, Automotive Technology, Electrical Engineering, and Graphic Design.

Concept

In 2027, the Erasmus Programme will celebrate its 40th anniversary. Over the past four decades, Europe has developed one of the most significant educational and social innovations of our time: transnational learning mobility. Through programmes such as Erasmus+ and other educational cooperation initiatives, more than 16 million young people have had the opportunity to undertake learning experiences in international settings, transforming mobility from an individual opportunity into a shared cultural asset.

These experiences have not only strengthened professional and transversal competences but have also contributed to shaping a new generation of European and global citizens, capable of navigating different cultures, education systems, and social contexts.

Today, in an increasingly interconnected and complex world, educational mobility is no longer exclusively a European dimension. It is progressively expanding into a global space for learning, cooperation, and civic engagement. In this context, a fundamental question arises: what kind of citizenship emerges from the experience of mobility?

DO YOUR MOB 2026 explores mobility as one of Europe's most important innovations of the contemporary era: not simply an educational tool, but a transformative practice that has helped redefine the very concept of citizenship.

The theme of this edition—"Towards 40 Years of Erasmus: Learning Citizenship through Mobility"—is based on the idea that citizenship is not merely a set of rights or theoretical knowledge, but an experiential learning process that develops through movement, intercultural encounters, and active participation.

From this perspective, mobility becomes:

- a transformative learning experience;
- a space for the construction of multiple and inclusive identities;
- a laboratory for developing civic and social competences;
- a driver of democratic participation and social inclusion.

DO YOUR MOB 2026 invites participants to reflect on how Europe's legacy of learning mobility can contribute to building a more aware, active, and responsible global citizenship, capable of addressing the challenges of an increasingly interconnected world while reinforcing the democratic values that unite our societies.
